ICCI CONFERENCE - A NEW FORMAT OF BUSINESS COMMUNICATION

Once again Tashkent gathers experts and specialists in the construction industry at the **4th ICCI International Conference of Construction Industry**. It has been a tradition that the Conference is held within the framework of the largest Uzbekistan International Construction Exhibition - UzBuild.

ICCI is the only discussion platform for construction industry in Uzbekistan dedicated to all stages of construction: from preparatory work to management of the finished facility.

During two days, **28 speakers and over 300 delegates from Austria, Kazakhstan, Russia, the USA, Turkiye, Uzbekistan, France and Sweden** will discuss modern trends in construction and new approaches to addressing the most relevant issues of real estate management.

ICCI 2023 will be held in the format of focus sessions with specific topics. The rich programme of the event will provide an opportunity to get insights, conduct a direct dialogue and exchange opinions with many distinguished participants.

The Conference delegates include representatives of large foreign and domestic construction companies, leading experts in the field of construction, production of finishing and building materials, specialists in construction and real estate management, urbanists, developers, representatives of academia, architects, designers and specialists from related industries.

The main topics of the Conference:

- Modern construction: new approaches, concepts and international standards;
- Production development of building materials;
- Commercial real estate;
- Hospitality;
- Construction management;
- Transformation and digitalization of the industry;
- Laminate flooring and decorative panels;
- Green construction;

The conference participants will get insights that will undoubtedly help them in addressing many problems and difficulties encountered in construction.

Representatives of Koç Construction, Kastamonu, Semrén & Månsson and the International Finance Corporation (IFC) will share their experience and opinions on new approaches, concepts and international standards in construction.

A key aspect of any construction is the production and use of building materials, therefore the Conference includes several sessions on this topic. Issues related to production of building materials, laminate flooring, decorative panels will be discussed by Kastamonu, Akhangarancement JSC, Latuning Pro, Ecoton Sharq and others.

The Commonwealth Partnership as the leading real estate consultants will present their real estate insights on retail, hospitality and construction management. Representatives from Project 2018, High Architecture International, Accor, Golden House, Balton Trading Asia and HMPartners will also participate in discussions at those sessions.

The construction industry is one of the most dynamically developing sectors with active implementation and use of IT solutions and digitalization. Within the framework of the Conference, a particular attention will also be paid to the issues of transformation and digitalization of construction, BIM technologies will be presented, as well as possible use of artificial intelligence at various construction stages. PlanRadar Software Trading, M-Project Kz LLP (Marks Group) and Live Soft International will share their experience in this area.

Also, within the framework of the Conference, a special session of the International Financial Corporation (IFC, World Bank Group) will be held on standards and international certification system for green construction.
